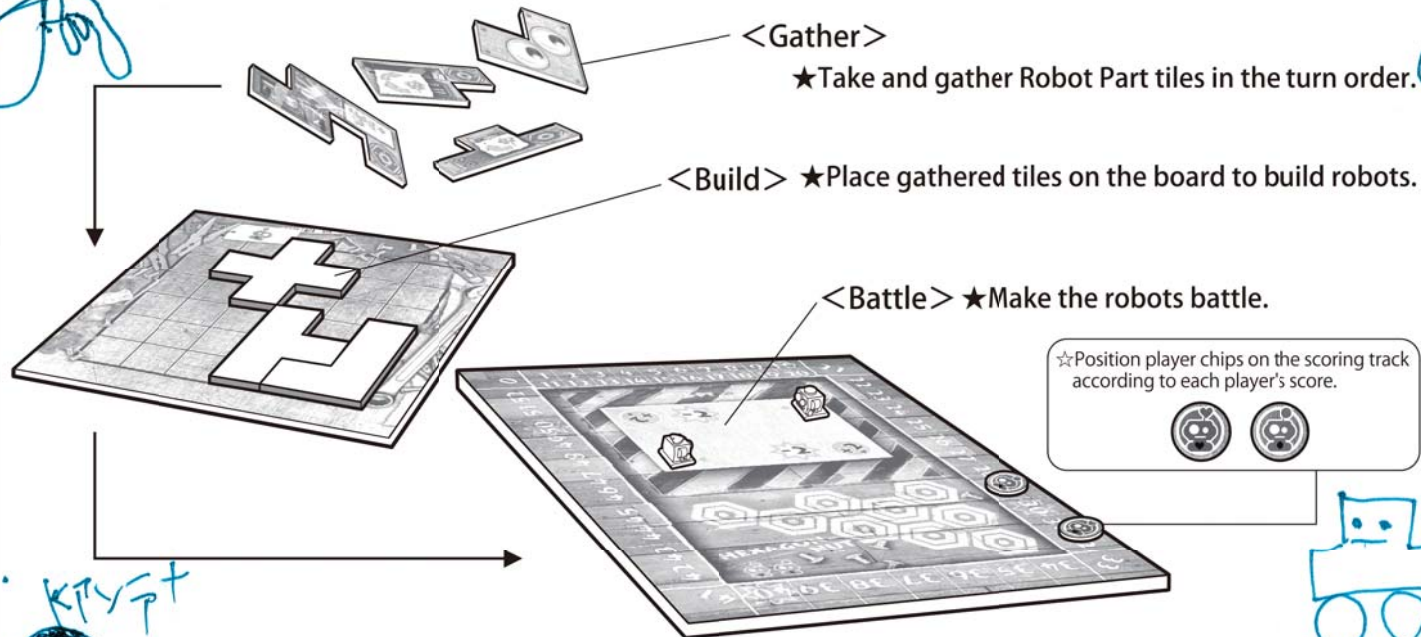


Note : What is Hebocon?

- Hebocon is a robot sumo-wrestling competition for those who are not technically gifted. It was first launched in 2014 by Hebocon master Daiju Ishikawa and the 1st Hebocon tournament was held on July 19 in Tokyo. Hebocon was included in the Jury Selections of Japan Media Arts Festival that year and was covered by the media across the world. Hebocon is currently held in 25 countries by local organizers. (as of October 2017)
- The word "Hebocon" derives from the Japanese word "Hebo", which is used to describe something that is technically poor, or low in quality. The object of Hebocon is to enjoy Heboiness.
- This game is themed on Hebocon. Build your original robots (imagined) for battle.

1 Order of Play

In this game, "gather parts", "build robots", and "battle". The player with the highest point wins.



●The player who has gained the highest points from <Build> and <Battle> wins.

2 Set Up

When opening the game box, check if all the components are in it.

- 1 Battle board
- 36 nuts
- 1 timer
- 4 player pieces for the battle
- 4 player chips
- 36 Robot Part tiles
- 4 Battle board scoring chips

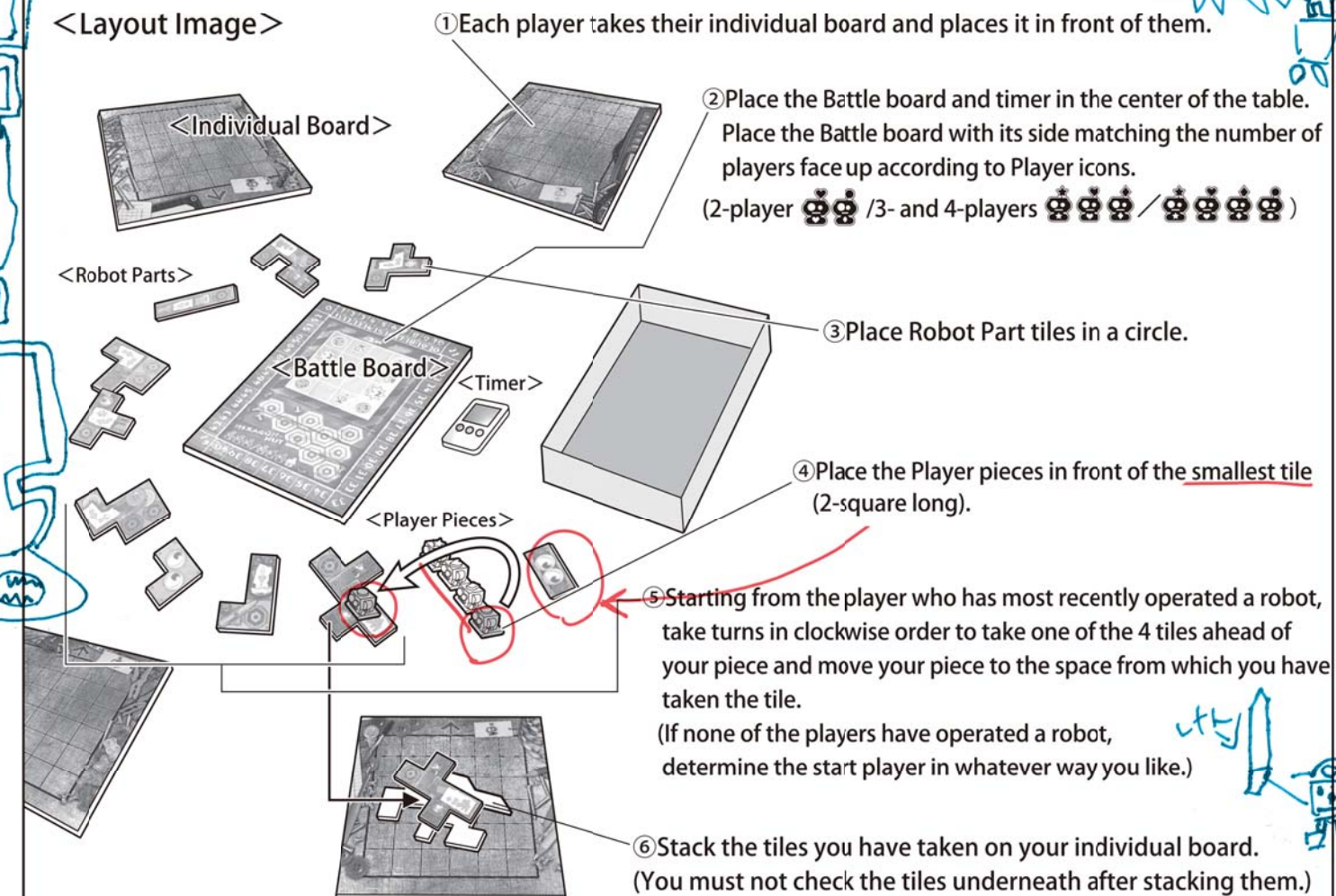
